

WHISSONSETT ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

Minutes of the Whissonsett Annual Parish Meeting held on Monday 12th May 2025 at 7.00pm in the Village Hall.

Present: Cllr Sally Dye (Chair of the Parish Council) and seven members of the public.

1. Welcome and apologies for absence.

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting. Apologies were received from County Cllr Kiddle-Morris.

2. To approve the minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on 13th May 2024.

The minutes of the meeting held on 13th May 2024 were approved and signed by the Chairman.

3. OUR GREEN SPACES – tell us what you would like to see at our village green spaces; the playing field, allotments or new land at Church Close. What can we do to improve them?

A member of the public asked for an update in respect of the allotments.

The Chairman said that work was ongoing to clear the site and the hedge has been cut. They are nearly ready to be let again. Council has investigated the cost of installing a water supply but at over £6,000 it is too expensive and not viable. Other suggestions were considered including IBC tanks etc. It was agreed that having no water at the site is a drawback.

A member of the public asked about grass cutting at Church Close land and a bench was also suggested.

The Chairman said that the working party will soon be meeting again and all ideas will be taken into consideration as well as confirming a grass cutting schedule. A woodchip path is also being considered.

4. OPEN FORUM - an opportunity for residents to express their views on other matters of interest or concern relating to the village and to suggest ideas for the future.

There were no matters raised.

5. To confirm the date of the next annual parish meeting – Monday 11th May 2026.

The date of the next meeting was noted and the Chairman closed the meeting at 7.20pm.
